Do what you can. It doesn't need to be perfect. I haven't lost any pay yet! Hahaha

Anything worth doing is worth doing wrong. Mistakes are not fatal.

I'm not very organized. There is always a shortage of time. The best way for me to learn is here - being of service.

Struggling with inadequacy kept me from service.

I get so much by giving it away. I wish I'd done it sooner.

District meetings are where I see the "Al-Anon heavyweights".

I like companionship & knowing people. I know I can ask them for help.

When I moved, I got into service to get to know people.

I can be a leader now. People let me lead because I was letting others do their jobs. I didn't micromanage like I did before.

People don't beat each other up when there is a mistake. I beat myself up but not you.

When you live in a service position, you own it. Now it is about you. I learned to let it go when my time is up.

I get to do service with people who do service using the Traditions and Concepts.

My sponsor "drug" me around to the different things she did in service. She always said she enjoyed that service so I went with her. I realized that I enjoyed it too.

I don't know what I'll do when this position ends. I know there will be something. I'm OK with not knowing right now. Being busy is part of my disease.

I didn't want to be here. I didn't like coming. I realized I could choose what I wanted and that made me a little more confident.
